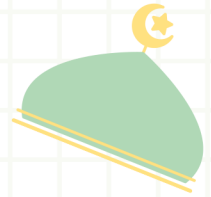

THE SIGNIFICANCE AND VIRUES OF EID AL-ADHA

The day of Eid-ul-Adha coincides with the tenth day in the final (twelfth) month of the Islamic Lunar Calendar: Dhu-al-Hijjah.

On this special day, all Muslims come out to pray together and the day is spent celebrating with the community, family and friends, often wearing new or best outfit, exchanging forgiveness and greetings and marking it as a memorable day.

The celebration of Eid-ul-Adha is a symbolic commemoration of the Prophet Ibrahim's devotion to Allah SWT and his readiness to sacrifice his son, Ismail. At the very point of sacrifice, Allah SWT replaced Ismail with a ram, which was to be slaughtered in place of his son. Therefore, Eid-ul-Adha means "The Festival of Sacrifice".

The act of Udhya/Qurbani (sacrifice) is carried out following the Eid Salaah and consists of slaughtering an animal (sheep etc.) as a sacrifice to mark this occasion to eat the meat and share it with family, friends, and to be donated to those in need.

The important lessons to be learnt from this occasion are about devotion, unity in submission to Allah, enjoying his favours, remembering and thanking Him in abundance.
